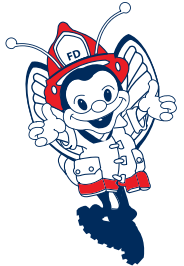

Make this home fire safe! Draw a line from each safety message to the safety hazard in the house.

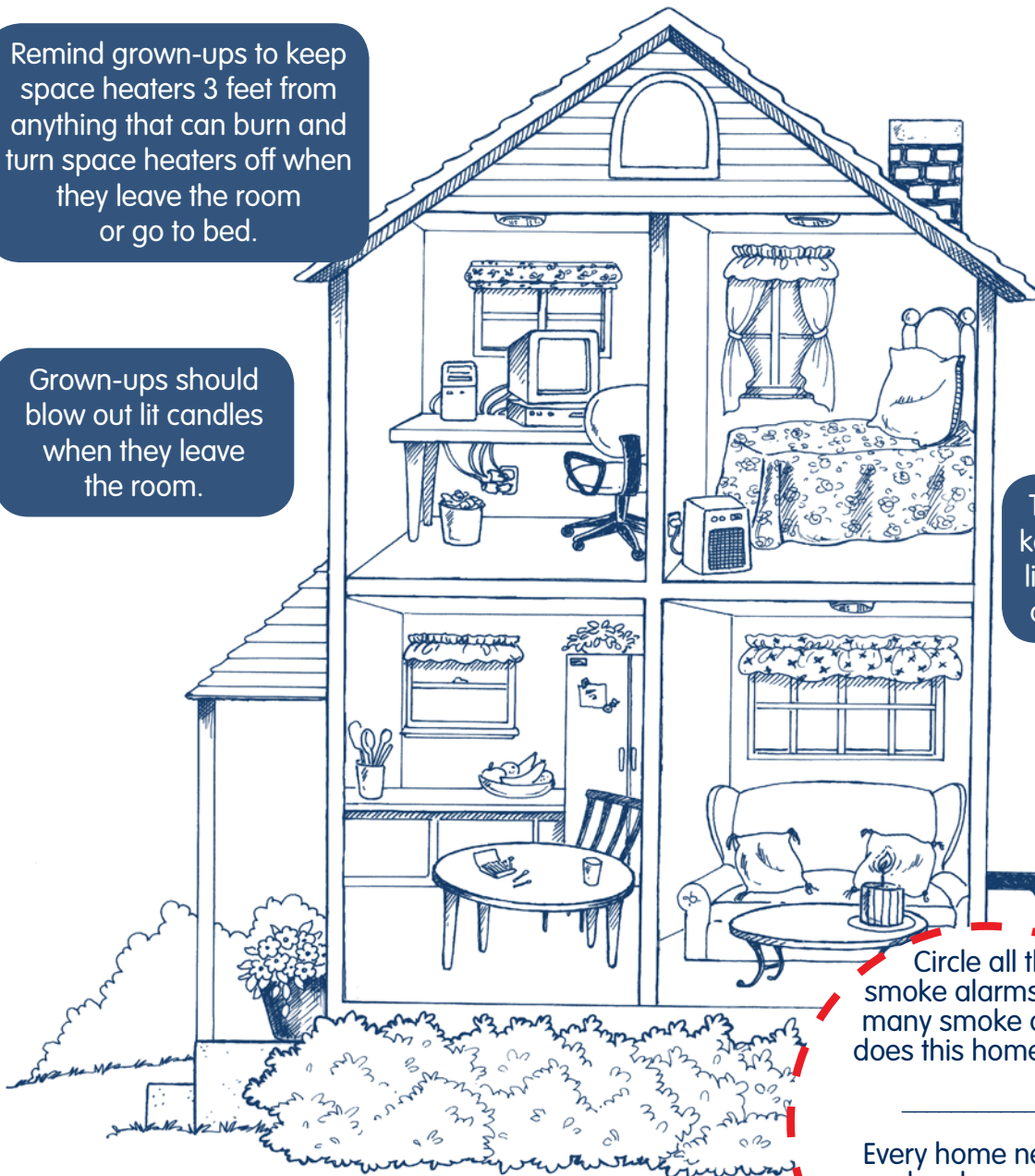


Remind grown-ups to keep space heaters 3 feet from anything that can burn and turn space heaters off when they leave the room or go to bed.

Tell grown-ups to keep matches and lighters up high in a locked cabinet.

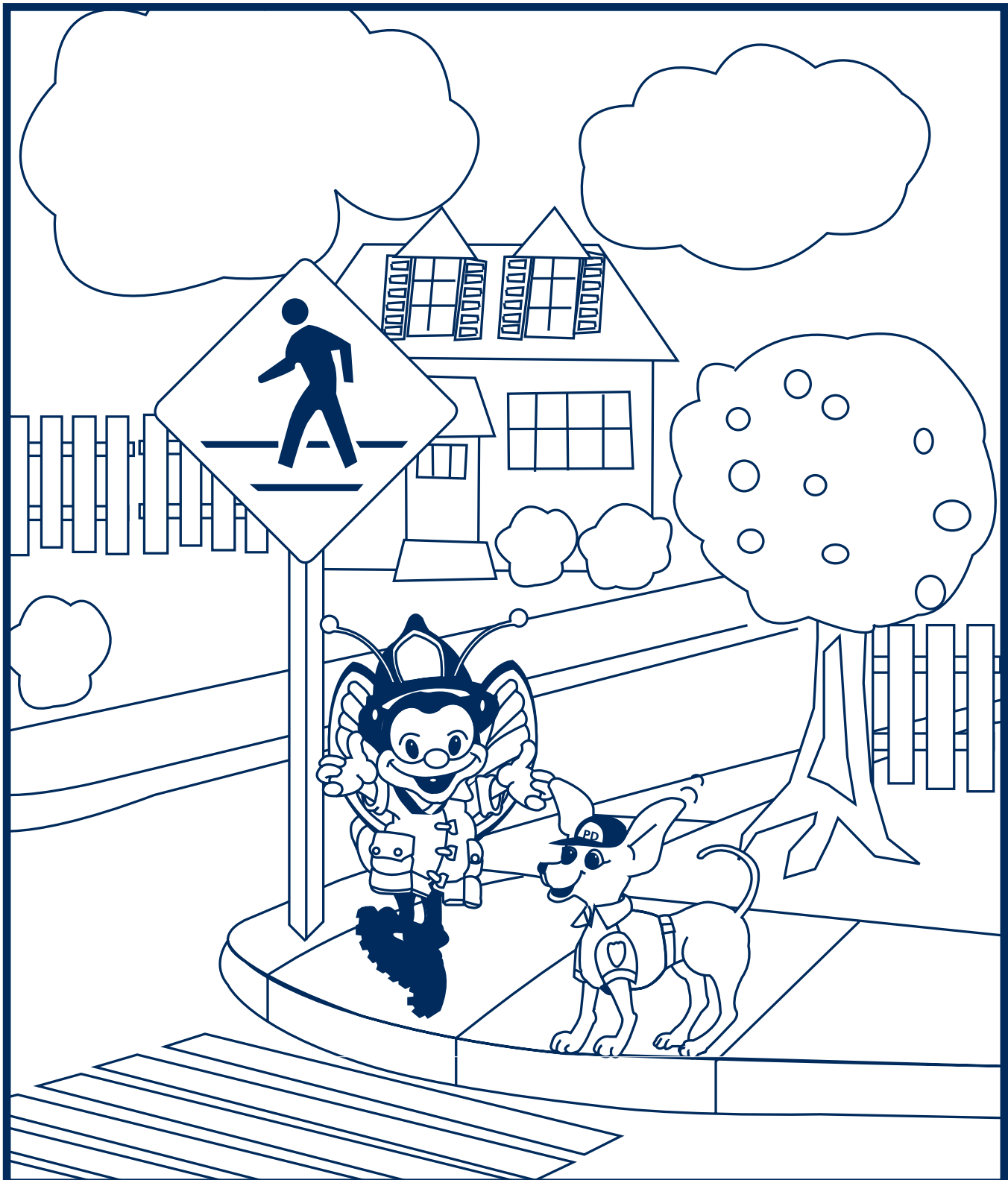
Crossing the Road Tips
